## Competitions to expand for CSC

**“BRING CARDS”** In May CSC will be holding the first Card competition of the year. With little time to prepare, we felt that the competition should be as open as possible and thus, the theme for the upcoming card competition is “BRING CARDS”. Members are invited to enter up to four cards per competition. Each entry will be rated by three judges. The three ratings will be combined to make up the total score of that entry. Once all entries have been scored, judges will use the total scores to award prizes and points for the competition. These points will be tallied and yearly awards will be presented. Awards such as “Slide of the Year”, “Points Leader”, “Most Improved”, “Most Entries” will be awarded. The plan is that awards will be presented at the CSC’s Annual Meeting held in April each year.

Note: **The July slide competition theme is “THE WET LOOK”**, so put on your thinking cap and get creative. Start shooting!

## Sunny 16 Rule

For us Norwester’s Spring means the return of sunny days.

- Use any speed film on a bright sunny day in middle latitudes.
- Base exposure on aperture of f/16
- Set shutter speed to as close as possible to 1/ISO of film (e.g., ISO 100 – use 1/90 to 1/125)
- For other conditions, keep same shutter speed but change f/stop – f/11 for hazy sun, f/8 for bright clouds (no sun), f/5.6 for open shade on a sunny day
- Use this rule to determine exposure when scene is difficult to meter (e.g., high contrast, use strong backlight)
- Also use the concept to check your metering technique or a malfunctioning meter

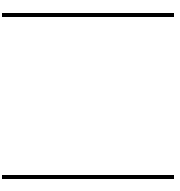
