CSC Exhibitions

“BRING CARDS” At the coming meeting, CSC will be holding the first stereo card exhibition (competition) of the year. The theme for the upcoming card competition is “BRING CARDS”. Members are invited to enter up to four cards. Each entry will be rated by three judges. The three ratings will be combined to make up the total score of that entry. Judges will use the total scores to set awards for the competition.

Note: **The July slide exhibition (competition) theme is “THE WET LOOK”**, so put on your thinking cap and get creative. Start shooting!

Last month's results and how it all works

These 10 persons entered slides in the International Stereo Club Competition: Greg Marshall, Neil Steller, Ted Welker, Ron Kriesel, Alan Rogers, Howard Wade, Mike Kersenbrock, Shab Levy, Gordon Battaile and Jerry Weigel. The winners were: 1st – Neil Steller, “Shipboard Café”, 2nd – Gordon Battaile, “A Shoulder to Lean ON”, 3rd – Gordon Battaile, “Dandelion Protrusion”, 4th – Howard Wade, “X-mas Lights”, 5th – Shab Levy, “Old Town At Night”, and 6th – Mike Kersenbrock, “?”.

The CSC Competition Committee now has a set of rules accepted by the Board. The paper includes suggestions for the logistics of our competitions, judging guidelines and points to be awarded. Ask for your copy.

Three judges score the entries on a 1-9 or 1-50 basis (depending upon electronics available). The combined judges score determine the awards to be given, the top six in this case.

Second is that points are awarded to all entrants, the winners and the judges to establish annual point accumulations and awards for CSC members.

These points will be tallied and yearly awards will be presented. Awards such as “Slide of the Year”, “Points Leader”, “Most Improved”, “Most Entries” will be awarded. The plan is that awards will be presented at the CSC's Annual Meeting held in April each year.

Here is the spread: 1 pt.-non-award-winning entry; 2 pts.-honorable mention (could be more than one); 4 pts.-third prize; 5 pts.-second prize; 6 pts.-first prize. Each judge receives 4 points for their participation (no entries). A maximum of 10 points only can be earned per event.

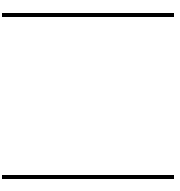
