SUMMER PHOTO CLASSES

Are you longing to improve your photographic skills this summer? Portland Community College is offering photography classes covering such topics as low light and after dark shooting, outdoor portraits (models will be provided), infrared photography, and Beginning Photography II. Each class is four sessions (twelve hours of instruction) with fees ranging from \$32 to \$56. Mike Riches, a freelance photographer, teaches the classes.

Last summer, Shab Levy and I took the Portland After Dark class from Mike. The first class is a lecture with handouts and questions and answers. The second and third classes are field trips around Portland at night taking pictures.

At the fourth class, students bring in the pictures/slides from the field trips and analyze the results, ask questions, and share advice. I was surprised how much I learned in only four classes! Mike was interested in what we were doing and the whole class enjoyed seeing the 3-D results of our two field trips. Mike's classes often fill up, because he

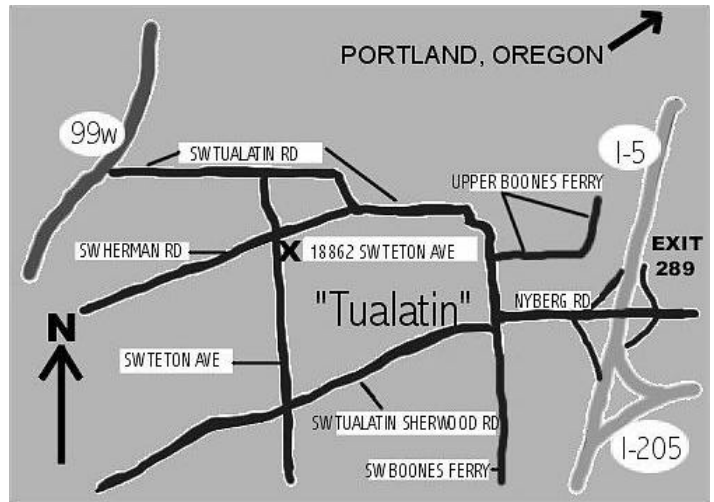

INTERNATIONAL STEREOSCOPIC UNION - Club Circuit

The ISU is an international organization comprised of individual and club members. CSC is a member of the ISU. Every two years the ISU has an international congress which meets and draws 3-D enthusiasts from all over the world. The next congress will be held in Sidney, Australia in September 2001.

At the last congress in Lindau, Germany, it was proposed that the ISU start a slide circuit to circulate among the various clubs who belong to the ISU. When I discussed this proposal at our CSC meeting in April, our members were enthusiastic about exchanging stereo images with other clubs around the world.

CSC needs to choose 10 slides from CSC members. The slides will be gone for at least a year going from one club to the next to be viewed by clubs internationally until it returns to us. At that point, we can view all the slides from the other clubs, remove our slides and put in 10 different slides for the next trip around. This is a wonderful chance to see the work of stereo photographers from far off places and different cultures.

At our June meeting, we will have a competition to choose the 10 CSC slides which will make the first round of the ISU Circuit. **Please bring four of your quality slides for judging.** Although the slides will be gone for a long time, stereographers have an excellent reputation for safeguarding stereo images so we expect they will return in good order.

Roundhouse tour:

Eight of the members of CSC enjoyed the trip to the Brooklyn Roundhouse to see, up close, several old steam locomotives with 7 foot wheels, 15 foot long connecting rods, 28 inch pistons, 20 foot high boilers, and a lot of massive engine parts everywhere, all accompanied by the sound effects of Obie's hat.

The SPS 700 was having its boiler pipes rebuilt and other major repairs, so we got to see a lot of the it's inner workings. The 4449 was there all put together and Shab found out that it will be repainted (all black) and go on a long tour around the US. It should be leaving some time in July, and maybe some one would like to take pictures of it in action. There was another engine, circa 1900, being worked on with spoked wheels and a dome on the top, and another that was just the boiler. It's impressive to see size of these things.

The outside was interesting as well with wheels, steam pipes, and lots of discarded used parts laying around. There was also an old turn table and several newer diesel engines.

I was busy taking pictures my self so didn't see what every one was doing, but I'm sure you will all see the 3D pictures soon, and you just need to hear about Obie's hat.
