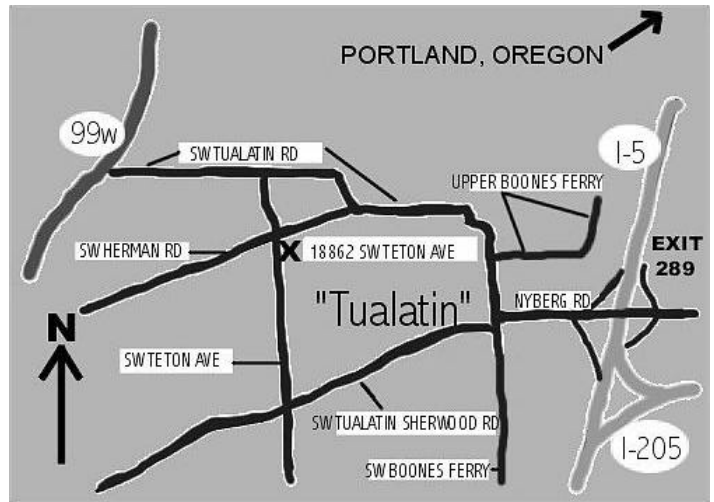
Take time to look over the CSC library at a meeting. Check something out for your home reading.

**CSC ANNUAL PICNIC - September 23, 2000**

CSC's annual members and family potluck will be held this year in Laurelhurst Park on Saturday, September 23. We have reserved Area F from 8 am until 2 pm. The park, which was designed by Massachusetts landscape architects Olmsted Brothers (sons of Frederick Olmsted, the designer of New York's Central Park), affords many photo opportunities, a duck pond, a playground for children, a horse-shoe pit, beautiful paths and rolling slopes, surrounded by gracious old homes from the 1920s and 30s. The planners envisioned a central community park surrounded by homes for all income levels from large palatial mansions to small one and two bedroom bungalows. With the collaboration of Emanuel Mische, a horticultural specialist, construction of the park began in 1910. Mische planned 15,000 linear feet of pathways, the planting of hundreds of trees, construction of a spring fed lake, and installation of 53 lamps designed to give the park a fairyland look. In 1919, Laurelhurst Park was voted the most beautiful park on the West Coast by the Pacific Coast Parks Association.

Mark your calendars now and encourage your family and friends of 3-D photography to join us at this annual event. We will begin eating around noon. Plan to bring your favorite dish to share and your camera. Our permit allows participants to bring beer or wine, if desired. There is ample parking on SE 36<sup>th</sup> and SE Ankeny.

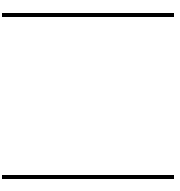
